THE INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF CHEIA

The XXIIIth edition of the International University of Cheia, organized by the Victor Dan Zlatescu Club Association in partnership with the Faculty of Public Administration of a National School of Political and Administrative Studies Bucharest, Faculty of Law and Administrative Sciences, the Faculty of Law from Cluj-Napoca of the “Dimitrie Cantemir” Christian University, the Ilfov-Arbitration Court, the Arbitral Institute, the United Nations Association in Romania, the members of the International Institute of French Expression and Inspiration and the European Law Institute, was held from 23 to 29 July 2017.

This scientific event brought together, as ever, dedicated specialists in the field of law and other humanities. The theme “Priorities in the field of law” offered to present participants the opportunity to present news from their fields of activity in the conditions of evolution of contemporary society.

After an opening session where greetings and speeches were presented by the leaders of the organizing institutions as well as representatives of the European Union Agency for Fundamental Rights (FRA), the Romanian Parliament, the Institute of Administrative Sciences of the Republic of Moldova, plenary sessions followed on topics of great interest. The first plenary session was dedicated to the United Nations - a universal organization for the defense and preservation of peace, for the encouragement and respect of human dignity and of human rights and fundamental freedoms, with the prof. Irina Moroianu Zlatescu PhD. and moderator Florin Emeric Saghi-minister counselor MAE. The next plenary session referred to human rights priorities at international level, highlighting aspects of promoting the principles of universality, indivisibility, interdependence and inter-relationship of human rights. It offered the opportunity to the rapporteur, Paula Ghițescu-Cocea, and to the moderator Prof. Monna Lisa Belu-Magdo PhD., ELI member, to bring to the attention of the present cases from

the European and national jurisprudence that support the views expressed in the exposition of the theme. A plenary session of special interest related to achievements and perspectives in the field of human rights at the 10th anniversary of the creation of the FRA, moderator being Prof. Mihai Milca PhD., and rapporteur Prof. Irina Moroianu Zlatescu PhD. The next plenary session brought into discussion the comparative human rights elements regarding the regional organizations, instruments and mechanisms in the field of protection and promotion of human rights, having as rapporteur Associated Prof. Elena Mihaela Fodor PhD., (Director of the Master's Program "Criminal Science and Criminology" at "Dimitrie Cantemir" Christian University, Faculty of Law Cluj-Napoca) and as moderator Prof. Maria Orlov PhD. (President of the Institute of Administrative Sciences of the Republic of Moldova). An issue of a stringent momentum - migration - was the subject of the plenary session that had as rapporteurs Alexandru Bucur, Petru Emanuel Zlătescu, Ioan Zonga- members ELI and Alexandra Țuică and moderator Florin Emeric Șaghi. A plenary session with the topic "Public administration, business environment and human rights", which was moderated by Associated Prof. Elena Mihaela Fodor PhD. and rapporteur Alexandra Cojocărescu. The plenary session "Contentious Means of Promoting Human Rights" plenary session, moderated by Elena Marinică PhD. and having as rapporteurs Geanina Antal and Alexandru Chiriță was also noted through the level of participation. The next, "Alternative Jurisdiction" Plenary Session, provided participants with the opportunity to learn news in the field of arbitration and mediation. Moderators were Alin Pop, CA-CAIB President and Mrs. Monna Lisa Belu Magdo-CACI, and rapporteurs Sorana Alina Paun Pop, Petru Emanuel Zlatecs, Alexandra Bucur, Andreea Nicolae, Nicolae-Dănuț Brebeanu, Alexandru Chiriță, Raphael Gautschi. A particularly recent topic, to which a plenary session was dedicated, referred to European and national legislation reflected in notarial acts, the rapporteur being Elenna Marinica PhD. and moderator Monica Pop. A new vision on the harmonization of national civil and commercial law with the international one was the theme of the session where Alexandru Chiriță, Geanina Antal, Daniel Cazacu were moderators and Prof. Monna Lisa Belu-Magdo PhD. was the rapporteur. The plenary session "New concepts in the field of human rights and rights" offered the possibility to the moderators, Associated Prof. Mihaela Elena Fodor, PhD., Prof. Marcela Stoica PhD., Daniel Cazacu and Sonia Stoica to bring to the attention of participants the issues related to the right to happiness, climate change and the environment. The draft third human rights covenant, which should be devoted to the right to the environment, and which will be launched at the UN General Assembly this autumn in New York, being devoted to a special debate coordinated by Prof. Irina Moroianu Zlatescu PhD. and Florin Emeric Șaghi. A Plenary Session entitled "For a Culture of Peace, Democracy and Human Rights", moderated by Andrei Nicolae, Member of the Chamber of Deputies' Culture Committee and having as rapporteurs Prof. Mihai

Milca PhD. and Prof. Magda Jianu PhD., highlighted the legislative priorities related to this field, at national level, according to the international standards in the field. We also note the two plenary sessions on opportunities in contemporary education: “Legal Education. Education for Human Rights” which had as rapporteurs Prof. Maria Orlov PhD., Prof. Mihai Milca PhD., Prof. Marcela Stoica PhD. and Roxana Elena Vişan and as moderator Prof. Magda Jianu PhD.

The debated topics covered a wide range of subjects from several legal disciplines. The plenary sessions provided the opportunity for participants, personalities from different countries and different legal horizons to discuss various themes, the studies presented and the debates will certainly find themselves in a volume that will include both plenary session reports and debates, interested in information and valuable analyzes, we hope both the theorists and practitioners of law, and why not, the legislature and the executive.
