

**9<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE LAW  
AND ADMINISTRATIVE JUSTICE FROM  
AN INTERDISCIPLINARY PERSPECTIVE**

The International Conference `Law and Administrative Justice from an Interdisciplinary Perspective`, at its 9<sup>th</sup> edition, took place from 24-26 November 2022, in a hybrid system, organized by the Department of Law - Victor Dan Zlătescu, from the Faculty of Public Administration (FAP – SNSPA), in partnership with the International Institute of French Expression and Inspiration Law in Paris and Sakarya University, Faculty of Political Science, Department of Economics, Turkey, with the collaboration of the Association for the United Nations in Romania - ANUURUM, member of the World Federation of United Nations Associations, the Academy of Legal Sciences, Romania, the Transdisciplinary Centre for Human Rights of FPA - SNSPA, the Club de la Cheia “Victor Dan Zlătescu”, etc. and started the scientific events dedicated to the Centenary of Romania's first democratic Constitution of 29 March 1923.

During the plenary session, opened by Professor PhD. Remus Pricopie, rector of SNSPA, and moderated by Professor PhD. Irina Moroianu Zlătescu, Professor PhD. Ioan Vida (President of the Constitutional Court of Romania 2004-2007) summed up the process of modernization of the Romanian state, highlighting the role played by the first modern Constitution of Romania (1866), while Professor PhD. Valer Dorneanu (President of the Constitutional Court of Romania 2016-2022) emphasised the importance of the fundamental law that shaped the new reality of Greater Romania, namely the 1923 Constitution, for the evolution of constitutionalism in Romania. The session continued, chaired by Professor PhD. Diana Camelia Iancu, Dean of FAP - SNSPA, with the topic *E-communication of Environmental NGOs or Climate Policy and Plans for Recovery in Bulgaria and Lithuania. What will be better?* presented by Professor PhD. Jaroslav Dvorak, Head of Department at the Klaipėda University, Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanity, followed by reports and debates on the administrative capacity of the judiciary, global challenges for the nation state and public administration, human rights in new realities and climate changes driven
